

Session Descriptions

Each day the conference will include:

<p><i>Panel Discussions</i></p> <hr/> 	<p>Lively livestream panel discussions to highlight progress, articulate key challenges, and illuminate the opportunities for emotional intelligence in higher education. These will include diverse voices including students, artists, administrators, and educators from multiple global regions & identities.</p>
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<p><i>Experiential Sessions</i></p> <hr/> 	<p>People immersed in bringing emotional intelligence to higher education will facilitate workshops to share a specific practice or process that's effective. These will be at least 75% learn-by-doing & facilitated by pairs or groups bringing aspects of intersectionality (e.g., students + faculty... facilitators from multiple countries... people of multiple racial or gender identities). Each session will end with a synthesis that will be recorded and included in the library.</p>


Session Descriptions

Each day the conference will include:

<p><i>Reflective Practice</i></p> <hr/> 	<p>Each day, groups will meet to engage at a human level, meeting people-as-people from across the higher education community (students, faculty, staff, administrators, parents & community members, government stakeholders, etc) to ground the work of this conference in the personal narratives through a reflective practice experience</p>
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<p><i>Roundtable</i></p> <hr/> 	<p>These sessions are an open-space format for collegial dialogue on a specific role, question, or tool. Each session will end with a synthesis or key recommendations to add to the library.</p>

<p><i>Community Resource Library</i></p> <hr/> 	<p>All participants will be invited to share in a curated library either short videos, documents, studies or other resources that will advance the work of emotional intelligence in higher education. These will be aggregated and shared along with a real-time survey of current needs in the community. The library will grow post-conference and continue via a schedule of stakeholder forums scheduled from now through to the next EQ in C&U Conference</p>
